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While it is important to protect the privacy of your residents and their health information, it is critical that facilities with positive COVID-19 cases continue to notify residents, families, authorized representatives, and staff.

As timely notification is key, the Agency wants to ensure every facility has a process in place to meet this expectation. Facilities should only disclose that a positive case has been confirmed and not the identity of the positive case.
