

Long Term Care Facilities Add'l Info - 1	Descriptions
<b>Current number of residents in your facility who are currently positive for COVID-19:</b>	Total number of current residents onsite in your facility who are currently COVID-19 positive based on test results. Exclude previous positives who are now cleared (based on test-based or symptom-based strategy). Do not include persons who were previously positive and have recovered.
<b>Number of former residents (discharged or transferred) who tested positive for COVID-19:</b>	Total number of residents who were COVID-19 positive while in your facility but were temporarily transferred or discharged from your facility because of COVID-19. Include transfers to hospitals or other health care facilities. Do not include transferred residents once they are cleared or would no longer be considered positive (based on a test-based or symptom-based strategy).
<b>For the previous day (12:00am to 11:59pm), total residents with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 that were transferred out of your facility to a hospital or health care facility:</b>	Number of COVID + or suspected residents transferred out of the facility yesterday.
<b>Designated area: Does your facility have a designated wing or building to isolate COVID-19 positive residents if needed?</b>	Answer Yes if you have a designated, distinct area in your facility with dedicated staff to properly isolate residents if they are positive for COVID-19.
<b>Accepting COVID admissions: Does your facility have a dedicated COVID-19 wing or unit AND are you accepting admissions/transfers of COVID-19 positive residents?</b>	Answer Yes if you are able to admit residents into a dedicated, distinct COVID-19 positive wing, unit, or building.
<b>Number of staff who have tested positive for COVID-19:</b>	Number of current employees who are currently positive for COVID-19. Exclude any staff who have recovered based on a test-based or symptom-based strategy.
<b>Total number of all staff (i.e. clinical, housekeeping, nutrition, maintenance, administration, and contract):</b>	Number of all current staff. Include all positions, all shifts, including contract.
<b>Are you currently conducting routine COVID-19 testing of your staff?</b>	Are you conducting routine surveillance staff testing on a schedule at this time. For example every week, biweekly or monthly staff testing.
<b>For the previous day (12:00am to 11:59pm), total number of staff that were tested for COVID-19</b>	Number of individual staff who were administered a COVID-19 test for the previous day
<b>For the previous day (12:00am to 11:59pm), total number of residents that were tested for COVID-19</b>	Number of individual residents who were administered a COVID-19 test for the previous day
<b>Enter your CLIA /CLIA waiver (lab) number</b>	If your facility holds a certificate or certificate of waiver from AHCA to perform laboratory tests from the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Act (CLIA) enter the CLIA ID number. If your facility is part of a health system and another lab in your system processes COVID tests for your facility, enter the CLIA number for that lab. For example: enter the hospital lab CLIA ID if the hospital processes COVID testing for a nursing home owned by a hospital.

<b>Masks: Average daily usage:</b>	The number of surgical and procedure masks on a daily basis that are taken from inventory which are no longer available for use.
<b>Masks: Days on hand:</b>	Number of days of supply you have left of surgical and procedure masks based on current inventory and usage rate.
<b>Masks: Do you have a scheduled delivery prior to depletion?</b>	Answer No if you will not be able to obtain additional surgical and procedure masks before your supply is exhausted.
<b>N95 Masks: Average daily usage:</b>	The number of N95 masks on a daily basis that are taken from inventory which are no longer available for use.
<b>N95 Masks: Days on hand:</b>	Number of days of supply you have left of N95 masks based on current inventory and usage rate.
<b>N95 Masks: Do you have a scheduled delivery prior to depletion?</b>	Answer No if you will not be able to obtain additional N95 masks before your supply is exhausted.
<b>Eye Protection/Face Shields: Average daily usage:</b>	The number of eye protection including face shields and goggles on a daily basis that are taken from inventory which are no longer available for use.
<b>Eye Protection/Face Shields: Days on hand:</b>	Number of days of supply you have left of eye protection including face shields and goggles based on current inventory and usage rate.
<b>Eye Protection/Face Shields: Do you have a scheduled delivery prior to depletion?</b>	Answer No if you will not be able to obtain additional eye protection including face shields and goggles before your supply is exhausted.
<b>Gowns: Average daily usage:</b>	The number of single-use gowns on a daily basis that are taken from inventory which are no longer available for use.
<b>Gowns: Days on hand:</b>	Number of days of supply you have left of single-use gowns based on current inventory and usage rate.
<b>Gowns: Do you have a scheduled delivery prior to depletion?</b>	Answer No if you will not be able to obtain additional single-use gowns before your supply is exhausted.
<b>Gloves: Average daily usage:</b>	The number of gloves on a daily basis that are taken from inventory which are no longer available for use.
<b>Gloves: Days on hand:</b>	Number of days of supply you have left of gloves based on current inventory and usage rate.
<b>Gloves: Do you have a scheduled delivery prior to depletion?</b>	Answer No if you will not be able to obtain additional gloves before your supply is exhausted.
<b>For the previous day (12:00am to 11:59pm), total number of staff who received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccination:</b>	Number of staff who received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccination yesterday.
<b>Total (cumulative) number of staff who have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.</b>	Cumulative number of all staff who received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine - count all staff vaccinated.
<b>For the previous day (12:00am to 11:59pm), total number of residents that received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccination:</b>	Number of residents who received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccination yesterday.
<b>Total (cumulative) number of residents who have received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.</b>	Cumulative number of all residents who received the first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine - count all residents vaccinated.
